

NOTICE TO ALL CLIENTS FOR THE DELIVERY OF MAIZE FOR THE 2022/2023 MARKETING SEASON

Dear Client,

GWK hereby gives notice of the maize storage options and tariffs which are applicable for the 2022/2023 season, which will be from 1st May 2022 to 30th April 2023.

All information in this notice is to be read in conjunction with the GWK master storage agreement.

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL TARIFFS EXCLUDE VAT.

ALSO, NOTE THAT THE RECOVERY OF STATUTORY LEVIES IS DONE IN ACCORDANCE TO RELEVANT LEGISLATION.

1. HANDLING COSTS

Product	Period	Rand per ton
Maize	1 May 2022 to 30 April 2023	R66.00

An additional R2,40 per ton will be charged for vehicles delivering, which are not fully self-discharging and where GWK must off-load the vehicle or part thereof by using labour.

2. STORAGE COSTS

2.1 DAY STORAGE TARIFF

2.2 CAP RATE

The day storage tariff cost is payable from date of delivery onto storage account, to a maximum of 150 calendar days. Should any stock be carried over to the next marketing season, the day storage rate, applicable to that marketing season, will be payable from the first day of that specific marketing season until the commodity is withdrawn from silos.

The right in terms of the cap rate is not transferable and, should transfer of ownership of stock take place, the user will pay the day tariff from date of transfer until such point that 150 calendar days are reached.

This option will only apply in respect to grain being held on storage account and not on grain held by virtue of a silo certificate.

In the case where stock is transferred for financing at a financial institution and the stock is transferred back to the user from the financial institution, the cap rate is transferable.

It is to be noted that a first-in-first-out principal is to be applied to deliveries and dispatch, therefore the oldest delivery will be dispatched first, even though other deliveries have not reached the cap rate.

3. SILO CERIFICATE TARRIFS

Silo certificates can be requested at the following administration cost for issuing of silo certificates.

3.1 JSE SILO CERTIFICATE

The day storage rate, as published by the JSE Commodity Derivatives Market for the specific marketing season, will be applicable to all silo certificates held and issued in terms of a JSE silo certificate.

When a JSE silo certificate is issued, the accumulated silo costs applicable to the storage option which applied until the date of such a certificate being issued, must be paid before such a certificate will be issued.

The certificate conditions as per the certificate and the JSE Commodity Derivatives Market will be applicable and all accumulated costs on the certificate need to be settled before any grain will be dispatched.

The user is entitled to convert a JSE silo certificate for stock at a GWK silo to storage account. Accumulated costs on the certificate must however be settled before such a conversion.

3.2 GWK SILO CERTIFICATE

The day storage rate as per 2.1 above for the specific marketing season will be applicable to all GWK silo certificates without a cap rate.

The certificate conditions as per the certificate will be applicable and all accumulated costs on the certificate need to be settled before any grain will be dispatched.

The user is entitled to convert a GWK silo certificate for stock at a GWK silo to storage account whereupon the costs accumulated on the certificate must be paid before such a conversion.

4. DELIVERY

GWK is not obliged to accept any grain tendered for delivery or storage.

4.1 HANDLING LOSSES

Grain delivered will be subject to physical losses and breakage during the handling and storage thereof and therefore the mass will be reduced with 1% (one percent) upon receipt.

4.2 EXCESS MOISTURE

The mass of grain delivered with a moisture content in excess of 12.5% (twelve comma five percent) moisture, will be reduced utilising the moisture formula, in order to equate it to a moisture 12.5% (twelve comma five percent).

4.3 DRYING TARIFFS

GWK reserves the right to stop the intake of maize with an excessive moisture content, should there be an over-supply of excessively moist maize and should the drying capacity be inadequate.

GWK shall, at its sole discretion and from time to time, accept grain with a higher moisture content at silos where drying facilities are available. The grain will then be dried at the cost of the client, subject to the applicable mass adjustment for excess moisture. Full information regarding the availability of and requirements in respect of the drying facilities is available at the relevant silo.

The applicable drying tariffs are as follows:

4.4 REMOVAL OF POISONOUS SEEDS

In order to assist the client with the cleaning of grain intended to be delivered for storage, the necessary facilities, where such facilities are available, are made available by GWK at a set tariff. Should a consignment of grain intended to be delivered for storage contain more than the permitted quantity of harmful seeds, the grain must be sifted slowly to remove all the harmful seeds. Full particulars relating to this service will be available from silo managers.

The applicable tariffs are as follows:

4.5 BAGGING AND MILLING OF MAIZE

Bagging and milling of maize where such facilities are available, are made available by GWK at a set tariff.

Full particulars relating to this service will be available from silo managers.

The applicable tariffs are as follows:

4.6 ADMINISTRATION FEE

GWK will issue a monthly stock report reflecting the product stored. Any additional administrative requests or additional stock reports will be charged at R179.00 per request.

4.7 GENERAL

Before grain can be delivered at a silo for the first time, the client wishing to deliver grain has to contact head office to ensure that an application to open a silo supply and storage account as well as a master storage agreement are completed, whereupon a storage account number will be allocated to the user.

The user is to verify operating hours with the silo directly as these may vary depending on seasonality requirements.

All physical deliveries at the silo must be accompanied by a fully completed "Geleibrief". Should the "Geleibrief" not be fully completed, the silo reserves the right not to accept the delivery. It is imperative that the correct cultivar being delivered is also indicated.

5. DISPATCH

All loading slots per silo must be pre-arranged with the Grain office before Thursday 16h00 for the following week.

All vehicles must be booked in the day before the loading slot, which was confirmed by GWK, by supplying the Grain office with a GWK goods declaration before 16h00.

Loading slots not utilised, or in the case where vehicles which were booked do not arrive on the day booked, will not be carried over and a new loading slot will need to be arranged for the following week.

Arrival times for vehicles at the silos – Monday to Thursday: 07h30 to 15h00. No vehicle will be accepted for loading after an arrival time of 15h00.

Arrival times for vehicles at the silos – Friday: 07h30 to 14h00. No vehicle will be accepted for loading after an arrival time of 14h00.

Arrival times for vehicles at the silos for loading at the farm – Monday to Friday: 07h30 to 12h00. No vehicle will be accepted for loading at the farm after an arrival time of 12h00.

All vehicles are loaded according to relevant food safety and road traffic legislation and no exceptions will be made.

Vehicles are subject to inspections by GWK, and GWK reserves the right to refuse the loading of vehicles that do not adhere to the required standards. Vehicles must be free from loose rivets, screws and bolts.

No contamination, foreign objects, pallets, wood chips, pests, insects, vermin, previous products, rust etcetera may be present. Tarpaulins and nets must be clean and in good condition without any tears or holes.

Vehicles to be loaded must be roadworthy.

Should the client require to make any other arrangement regarding the above, this arrangement must be confirmed with the relevant silo manager and could be subject to an additional cost charged by GWK.
